**** SNOW BUS ROUTES ****
August 1, 2011

The Cleveland Public Schools is establishing bus "Snow Routes" for those situations where the majority of the roads are passable, but there are still a few trouble spots. Snow Routes will allow us to run the majority of the bus routes with a few designated drop-off/ pick-up spots close to the problem roads. (example: students in an addition may meet the bus at the entrance to that addition.)

Announcements of the use of Snow Routes will occur through the same media outlets as school cancellations. Listed below are the areas that will have a centralized bus stop and where the centralized stop is located.

Students living in the following areas will be picked up and dropped off as noted:

- Bus # 3 Hermits Rest students at Hwy 64.
- Bus # 8 Benight Rd and Cedric Harris Rd and Terlton Rd to 48 Hwy go to 4 way east of Terlton
- Bus # 12 Washington Irving Cove north, Point Harbor, Candlewood Arms, and Ridgemont Estates to North Service Roads.
- Bus # 13 Cedar Creek Apt, to Hwy 64.
- Bus # 21 Westport and Hill-N-Dale to North Service Rd. To Hwy 64.
- Bus # 24 Toher Rd (formerly Scrapping Ridge) to Main Road
- Bus # 25 Benight Rd., Pickup at 4-way by Terlton or at Omstead's Market.
- Bus # 27 Cedar View Rd, Rigsby Rd, Sandy Point, to South Service Rd.
- Bus # 28 First Rd on Osage turn right, Prue Rd. (dead end) Circle M Addition, meet at Main Rd. Osage Rd.
- Bus # 29 Appalachia Bay, Keystone Colony, and Bears Glen, to South Service Road. Little Ponderosa area to main Ponderosa entrance, Washington Irving Cove South to North Service Rd.

NOTE: Parents be advised that the students will be dropped off in the afternoon at the same location as they were picked up in the morning. It is imperative that transportation be available from the Snow Route drop off point, to insure student safety to their homes.

(If transportation is not available, then parents must contact the school office with other instructions.)
